Practical Writing Short Course

Friday, May 13

Formal letters (requests of information, complaints, letter to a teacher, cover letter, CV, etc.):

Friday, May 20

Informal letters (letters and emails to distant friends/relatives, pen-pals, love letters, etc.):

Greeting cards for any special occasion:

Any special occasion that includes us or the people we love can be an opportunity for us to express feelings.

Friday, June 3

Short messages (text messages, abbreviations):

Brief does not mean a lack of content. We can be effective and incisive with a few well-written words.
