His insights are a potent antidote to our growing sense of gloom.

An expert on Dante and the Medieval Mediterranean world, Dr.

Daniela Boccassini teaches in the Italian program at UBC. She is also one of the directors of the Jung Society of Vancouver.

After the Q&A we will share some light refreshments and some conversation to end our evening.
